Edmonton Multicultural Coalition Board is looking for new Directors.

Background

Non-profit organizations, including the Edmonton Multicultural Coalition (EMC), rely on strong leadership to drive change and achieve their missions. The board of directors gives leadership and guides the strategic direction of an organization. Boards govern non-profits on behalf of their members and they are accountable to those members

If you're interested in volunteering on the EMC Board, first consider your skills, interests and experience. Consider whether you have time to commit to serving on the board. You should know the Coalition's history, vision and mission. And understand the board's role before joining. **If you've never been on a board, don't worry; there are training opportunities to help you.**

Responsibility and liability of volunteer board members

Board members have legal obligations and they are liable for their decisions. Directors are responsible for representing the interests of the organization. When directing the affairs of an organization, the board must act within the law. As a *trustee*, a board member must follow three basic principles: 1) **Diligence** – act reasonably and in good faith; 2) **Loyalty** – place the interests of the organization first; and 3) **Obedience** – act within the scope of the law.

What are the typical duties of a board member?

There are general duties and responsibilities that all board members should follow:

- Duderstand and show a commitment to the organization's mission and programs.
- I Keep up to date with issues and trends that affect the organization.
- Prepare for meetings by reading agendas, minutes, reports, etc.
- P Attend meetings regularly.
- Contribute skills and knowledge by participating actively in meetings, committee work.
- Ask questions when you don't understand something, or when you need more information.

Duderstand and monitor the organization's financial affairs.

Avoid any potential conflicts of interest; if you're in doubt, talk with the board chair.

2 Understand and maintain confidentiality.

Densure the organization is complying with all legal and regulatory requirements.

Who can be nominated?

Member in good standing can be nominated.

How many members are needed to nominate another member?

Two members who have been members of the Coalition for a full year are needed for each nomination.
