Prior to relocating to Edmonton, she taught middle school science on the Navajo Indian Reservation in New Mexico, and worked as a community organizer with urban Aboriginal and immigrant youth in Montreal. For her thesis work in health promotion, she collaborated with the Yellowknife's Dene First Nations communities in the Northwest Territories, exploring how physical activity is embedded in local culture and the northern environment. These experiences have directed her to a career path that combines grassroots organizing with improving the health and wellness of multicultural communities.
